AWARD SUMMARY

The aim of this course is to provide participants with the skills and knowledge to provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation to an adult, child or infant. The course content is based on the policies and standards of the Australian Resuscitation Council.

UNIT/S OF COMPETENCY

- HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

PRE-REQUISITES

To be eligible to receive this award, candidates must be at least 10 years of age on the date of final assessment.

RPL AND CREDIT TRANSFER

Candidates who believe they already possess some or all of the skills and knowledge of this award, may wish to apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) or Credit Transfer. These candidates should consult their Training Officer or State Centre for more information.

PATHWAYS

This unit is from the HLT Health Training Package and is not aligned to a particular qualification.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of this course participants should be able to:

- Respond to an emergency situation
- Respond to signs of an unconscious casualty
- Perform CPR
- Communicate details of the incident

ASSESSMENT

Assessment is through demonstration and questioning, addressing all aspects of competency and utilising simulated workplace scenarios. Participants will be required to complete activities that may include oral and written questioning, practical demonstrations and performing scenarios.

PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

For a CPR qualification to be recognised for use in a workplace, you must refresh your skills by completing a refresher course every 12 months. This is a requirement set by the Australian Resuscitation Council.
